**Satellite Polls for Absentee Voting Opens for November 6, 2018 General Election**

**WHAT:** KANSAS CITY, MO. – **Absentee satellite voting for the November 6 General Election begins October 22nd for Kansas City voters.**

**WHO:** Missouri election laws allow Kansas City registered voters who qualify for one of the following reasons to cast an absentee ballot in-person at an Absentee Satellite location:

1. Will be absent from their voting jurisdiction on Election Day
2. Are incapacitated or confined due to illness or physical or physical disability, or caring for an incapacitated person
3. Are restricted by religious belief or practice
4. Are employed by an Election Authority
5. Are incarcerated, but have retained all voting qualifications
6. Are a certified participant in the address confidentiality (Safe at Home) program established under sections 589.660 to 589.681 due to safety concerns

**KCEB:** Absentee voting is available at the Kansas City Election Board Absentee Office, located in Union Station, Suite 2800 (30 W. Pershing Road) 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. through Monday-Friday, and on Saturday, November 3 from 8 a.m. -12 noon. On Monday, November 5, in-person absentee is open until 5 p.m., or can be submitted by mail.

**OTHER:** Registered voters who qualify may download an absentee ballot application at [www.kceb.org](http://www.kceb.org) or call (816) 842-4820 ext. 225 to request an application. Your application form may be submitted by mail or fax to (816) 221-3348. The absentee application form must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 31, 2018, and a ballot will be mailed.

**The last day to submit an absentee ballot application for the November 6 election is Wednesday, October 31, 2018.**

**What's on the ballot**

The November 6 ballot contains 41 plus questions and races. Voters are encouraged to visit <https://www.kceb.org/elections/ballot/> to view and print the sample ballot prior to voting absentee or voting in person on election day. Voters may bring a sample ballot to the absentee office or to the polls on election day to aid in voting. Making selections ahead of time will speed up the voting process for everyone.

**Election Day**

The polls will be open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 6.

**Voter Registration Information**

New residents, or those not registered, must register by October 10, 2018 in order to be eligible to vote in the November 6 election. Voters who have moved since they last voted should submit a change of address form by mail (30 W. Pershing Road, Suite 2800, Kansas City, MO 64108), fax (816-221-3348) or in person (KCEB Office, Suite 2800) to KCEB to be assured of receiving a new voter ID card and their new polling location. You may now register or update your address online at <https://s1.sos.mo.gov/votemissouri/request>.

Kansas City (within Jackson County) has 221,171 registered voters. .
