Mayor Lucas Promotes Kansas City Election Board Efforts to Keep KC Safe ahead of June 2 Election

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (May 27, 2020) – Mayor Quinton Lucas informs voters of changes to standard voting procedures and encourages voters to check for their Voter Notification Cards for their proper polling location: **see email video attachment.**

Date, Time, Place: The election is Tuesday, June 2, 2020. Poll hours are 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Increased Health and Safety Measures: The School and Special Election originally scheduled for April 7 has been moved to Tuesday, June 2, 2020. For the health and safety of all voters, election workers and staff, the Kansas City Election Board will take the following safety measures.

- 1) Each Polling Place will have an 8 ft. protective barrier at each voter check-in table. Election workers will wear face coverings and gloves.
- 2) Hand sanitizer, alcohol wipes, Lysol wipes and anti-bacterium spray will be used frequently to clean equipment and other hard surfaces.
- 3) Sterilized styli will be used for voter check-in and Ballot on Demand voting.
- 4) Single use pens and pencils will be used for voters voting a paper ballot.

Polls: For additional safety, polling places have been moved to large centrally located spaces throughout the City. School gymnasiums, Community Centers and cafeterias will be used to ensure proper social distancing of voters and workers.
