# REORGANIZED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 7 (LEE'S SUMMIT) SPECIAL ELECTION APRIL 7, 2020

### **QUESTION**

Shall Reorganized School District No. 7 of Jackson County, Missouri (Lee's Summit) issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$224,000,000, resulting in no estimated increase to the debt service levy, for the purpose of acquiring property and constructing, renovating, improving, furnishing and equipping school sites and facilities, including:

- installing safety and security improvements throughout the District
- constructing a new middle school
- constructing an addition to and renovating Lee's Summit High School
- renovating Pleasant Lea Middle School, Bernard Campbell Middle School and Summit Lakes Middle School
- constructing an addition to and renovating Mason Elementary School

- renovating a portion of Prairie View Elementary School for early childhood education
- making improvements to the District's High School athletic/activities facilities and stadiums?

If this question is approved, the District's debt service levy is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.07 per one hundred dollars assessed valuation of real and personal property.
