CITY OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI SPECIAL ELECTION APRIL 3, 2018

QUESTION 1

SHALL THE FOLLOWING BE APPROVED?

Shall the City of Kansas City, Missouri reauthorize the existing 1% sales tax authorized by Section 94.510 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri for a period of 20 years to expire on December 31, 2038; continue to fund a capital improvements program for public needs including, but not limited to streets, bridges, curbs, sidewalks, flood control, parks, and public buildings; dedicate in this program 35% of the available annual sales tax receipts for neighborhood conservation, maintenance and improvements to be divided equally among council districts based on the recommendations of the Public Improvements Advisory Committee ("PIAC") and the final decision of the City Council; dedicate in this program, with review and comment by PIAC, at least 25% of

the available annual sales tax receipts for street resurfacing, repair, and construction of complete street facilities and the remainder for other capital improvements, including the City's share of the costs for the replacement of the Buck O'Neil Bridge?
