The Kansas City Board of Election Commissioners is seeking to fill the position of **Election Technician**. This position requires a HS diploma or equivalent combination of education and experience. Applicants must be proficient with working with electronic equipment and possess interpersonal and social skills.

Job responsibilities include:

- Assemble supply bags and signs
- Program and test voting equipment including minor repairs
- Perform general maintenance in assigned areas
- Understand Missouri Election laws as it applies to this position
- Maintain inventory of supplies and count supplies at conclusion of each election
- Check route sheets and lock lists
- Assist with equipment delivery prior to election day
- Ability to lift 50 lbs
- Assist with set up of equipment prior to election day
- Troubleshoot, service equipment and answer election judge questions on election day

- Must be self motivated and a self starter
- Other duties as assigned

In accordance with Missouri State Statutes, applicants for this position **MUST BE A REPUBLICAN, A REGISTERED VOTER AND RESIDENT OF KANSAS CITY** (within Jackson County) for at least one year.
