STEP 1

STEP 2

Complete an application to request a mail-in ballot in person or by mail. After receiving a ballot, fill it out and have the return envelope notarized.

STEP 3

Return your mail-in ballot through the **U.S. mail only.**

MAIL-IN: Who is Eligible?

You're eligible to vote by mail-in if you are a registered voter!

MAIL-IN PROCESS



Fill out mail-in ballot application.



Deliver to election authority by mail or in-person.



Receive and fill out mail-in ballot. Have envelope notarized.

Return to election authority through U.S. mail in time for its receipt by Election Day at 7 p.m.

STUFF TO KNOW

- Request a mail-in ballot from your local election authority.
- Mail-in ballots may be requested in person.
- Oct. 21 at 5 p.m. is the deadline to request a mail-in ballot by mail for the Nov. 3 election.
- Unlike absentee ballots, mail-in ballots MUST BE mailed back through U.S. mail.

<u>Application Request Form</u> - Must be returned by mail or in-person to Kansas City Board of Election Commissioners, 30 W. Pershing Rd., Lower Level B, #2800 K.C. MO 64108. <u>Application form DOES NOT</u> <u>need to be notarized. It is the *ballot envelope* you will return your ballot in that needs to be notarized.</u>

<u>Ballot</u> - Return completed ballot in <u>signed and notarized ballot envelope</u> to Kansas City Board of Election Commissioners <u>by mail ONLY.</u>
