Absentee Voting Deadlines Fast Approaching

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (Oct. 28, 2013) – Voters should be aware of upcoming absentee voting deadlines for the November 5 election.

In-person absentee voting ends at 5:00 p.m. November 4. Voters wishing to vote absentee in-person may come to the Kansas City Election Board Office at Union Station, 30 W. Pershing Road, Suite 610. Absentee voting hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on Saturday, November 2, 8:00 a.m. to noon.

If voters wish to vote absentee by mail, they may request an application by calling 816-842-4820 ext. 225, writing a letter, or downloading the application from www.kceb.org. All applications must be received by the Election Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 30.

All mail-in absentee ballots must be received by the Election Board no later than 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 5.

In-person absentee voting ends	5:00 p.m. Monday, November 4
Last day to request absentee ballot by mail	5:00 p.m. Wednesday, October 30
Last day absentee ballot submitted (by mail or drop off)	7:00 p.m. Tuesday, November 5
