In-Person Absentee Voting Kicks Off

WHAT:	In-person absentee voting began Tuesday, September 25 and ends at 5 p.m. November 5. Voters wishing to vote absentee may come to the Kansas City Election Board Office, 30 West Pershing Road, Suite 610, Kansas City, MO 64108. Voters must bring identification with them when voting in person.	
WHO:	Kansas City registered voters who qualify for one of the following five reasons:	
	 Will be absent from their voting jurisdiction on Election Day Are incapacitated or confined due to illness or physical disability, or caring for an incapacitated person Are restricted by religious belief or practice Are employed by an election authority Are incarcerated, but have retained all voting qualifications 	
WHERE:	KCEB Office, Suite 610 (lower level, west side of Union Station, next to the IRS office) 30 West Pershing Road Kansas City, MO 64108	
WHEN:	September 25 – November 5	
	Absentee voting hours are Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and on Saturday, November 3, 8:00 a.m. – noon.	
OTHER:	Registered voters may also vote absentee by mail by downloading the absentee ballot application at <u>www.kceb.org</u> or calling 842-4820 to request an application.
