Kansas City Election Board Readies Voters for November 4 Election

KANSAS CITY, MO. (Oct 30, 2014) – The Kansas City Election Board (KCEB) announces details for the upcoming November 4 election. Following are the specifics to ensure that voters have the information needed to participate in Tuesday's election.

<u>Date, Time, Place</u>: The election will be held Tuesday, November 4, 2014. Poll hours are 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Absentee Voting: Walk-in absentee voting at KCEB will end on Monday, November 3, at 5:00 p.m. All mail-in absentee ballots must be received by the election office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

In Missouri, voters need one of five reasons to vote absentee:

- 1.) Absence on Election Day from the jurisdiction of the election authority in which registered to vote
- 2.) Incapacity of confinement due to illness or physical disability, including a person who is primarily responsible for the physical care of a person who is incapacitated or confined due to illness or disability
- 3.) Religious belief or practice
- 4.) Employment as an election authority, as a member of an election authority, or by an election authority at a location other than your polling place

5.) Incarceration, provided all qualifications for voting are retained

Polls: Voters may find their polling location online at www.kceb.org by entering a last name and birth date in the *Check Your Voter Status* box, or by clicking on the *Poll Log* link on the KCEB homepage.

- 1) Wayne Miner Court (- former poll: St. Mark Union Church)
- 2) Spirit of Hope Church (- former poll: Salvation Army)
- 3) St. Peter's Church (- former poll: St. Peter's Legacy Center)
- 4) Annunciation Greek Orthodox Church (- former poll: Martin City Baptist Church)

<u>Election Notice Cards</u>: Cards were mailed to all active registered voters on Friday, October 24. The polling location and address are printed on each election notice card. Voters whose polls have changed will be reminded on their card.

<u>Voter Identification</u>: Voters may present any of the following forms of identification:

- 1) Missouri or out of state driver's license
- 2) Local, State or Federal government issued I.D. (employee, passport, social security card, military, etc.)
- 3) Missouri higher education I.D. (college or university)
- 4) Local election authority issued I.D.
- 5) Current bank statement, utility bill, government paycheck, or government document containing the voter's name and current address

Photo identification is not required to vote in Missouri
