Kansas City Board of Election Commissioners to Host Public Demonstration for New Voting Equipment

(June 14, 2017) – Several certified election system vendors will be demonstrating their newest, state of the art voting systems at two public demonstrations hosted by the Kansas City Board of Election Commissioners (KCEB). KCEB is slated to purchase all new voting equipment by the end of 2017.
