KCPS Redistricting Sample Maps To be Presented at Public Hearing

KANSAS CITY, MO (October 20, 2021) – The second public hearing for the redistricting of the Kansas City Public School subdistricts will be taking place this Thursday, October 21, 2021 at 6:00 PM in the KC Public School office located at 2901 Troost Ave. KCMO 64109. The purpose of this meeting will be to present five (5) sample maps for public review and input.

The final meeting, at which the three (3) final maps will be presented for public input, including any community-submitted maps, be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021 at 6:00 PM, also at 2901 Troost Ave. KCMO 64109. KCMO community members may submit comments, recommendations, and suggested maps by sending them to kcpsredistricting@kceb.org. All community maps must be submitted to kcpsredistricting@kceb.org by midnight on Monday, November 1, 2021 in order to be considered.

The Kansas City Board of Elections has been designated by statute to serve as the redistricting commission for the Kansas City Public Schools. The Board of Commissioners, sitting as the redistricting commission, is responsible to redistrict the Kansas City Public School subdistricts based on the results of the 2020 Census. The purpose of these hearings is to gather input from the KCMO community in an effort to create subdistrict maps that best reflect the needs of the KCMO community.
