SPECIAL BOND ELECTION REORGANIZED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 7 (LEE'S SUMMIT)

QUESTION

Shall the Reorganized School District No. 7 of Jackson County, Missouri board of education borrow money in the amount of \$40,000,000 for the purpose of acquiring land, constructing, furnishing and equipping a new building initially to be used for Summit Technology Academy and the Missouri Innovation Campus, completing safety enhancements and deferred maintenance, and constructing school facilities, building additions to and repairing, remodeling, renovating and improving existing district facilities and furnishing and equipping the same and issue bonds for the payment thereof resulting in no increase to the debt service levy?

If this proposition is approved, the debt service levy of the school district is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.0700 per one hundred dollars assessed valuation of real and personal property.

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating levy of the District will increase by \$0.24 from \$4.4300 currently to \$4.6700 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.
